

Reporting Period: Data through July 31, 2019


#### **Open 311 Shelter Waitlist Requests**

\*Open waitlist requests below are a point in time count captured once at the beginning of each month




#### 311 Available Beds vs. New Waitlist Requests


### **Occupancy Rate for All Shelters**

- 1,392 clients enrolled into the ONE System in August
- 143 families assessed by Access Points in August
- 655 adults assessed in August
- 78 youth assessed in August


