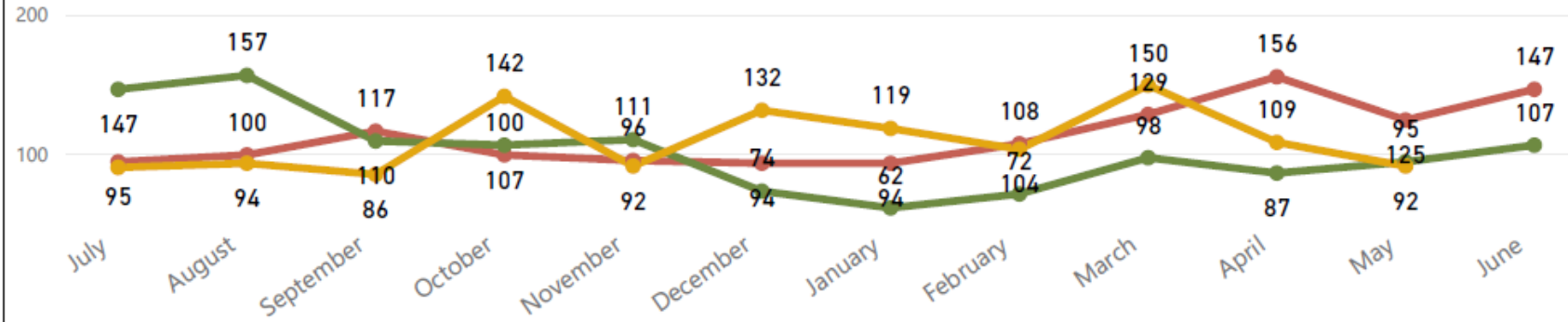

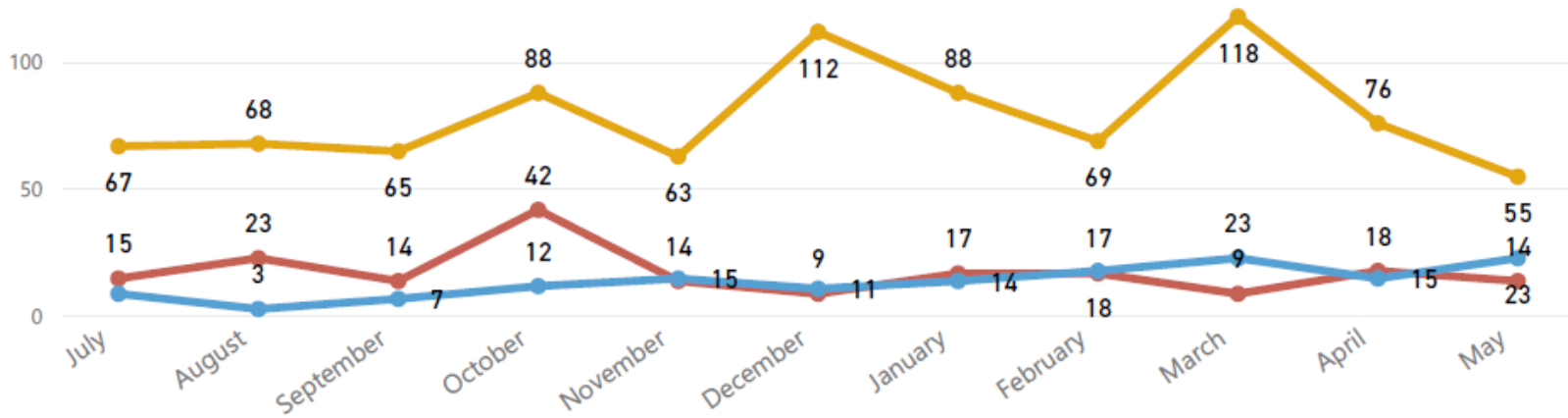

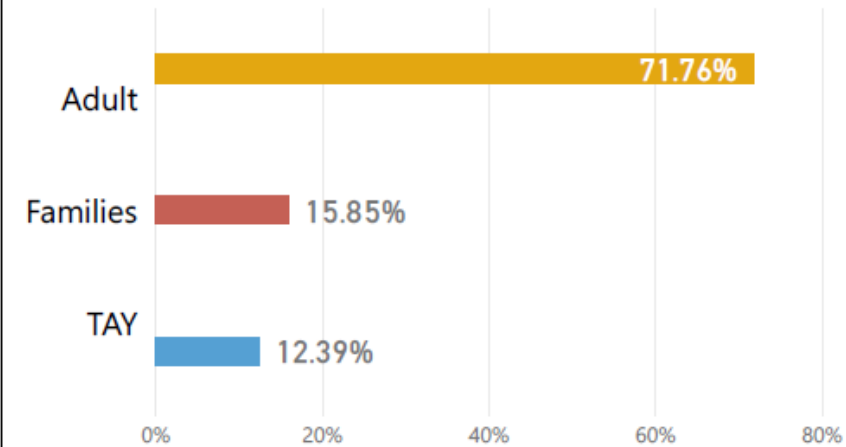
Placements by Population (FY2020)

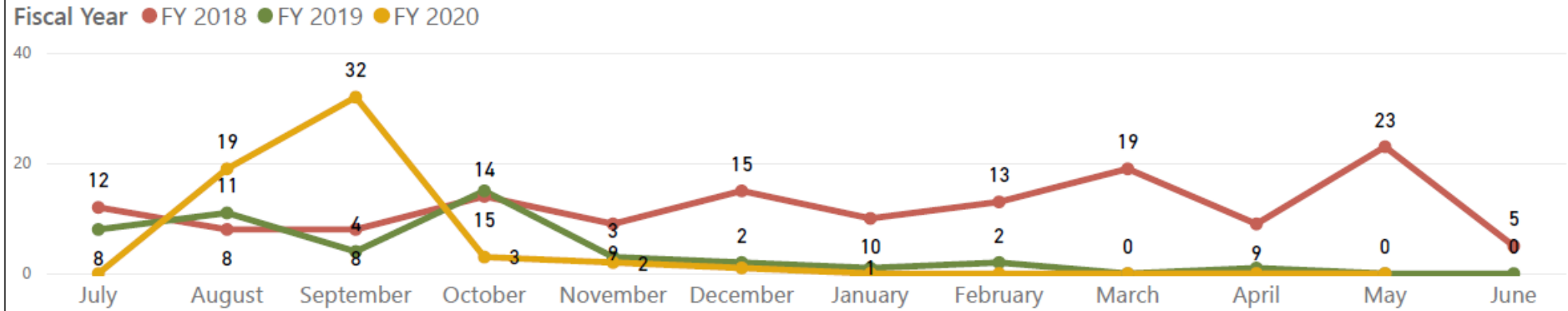

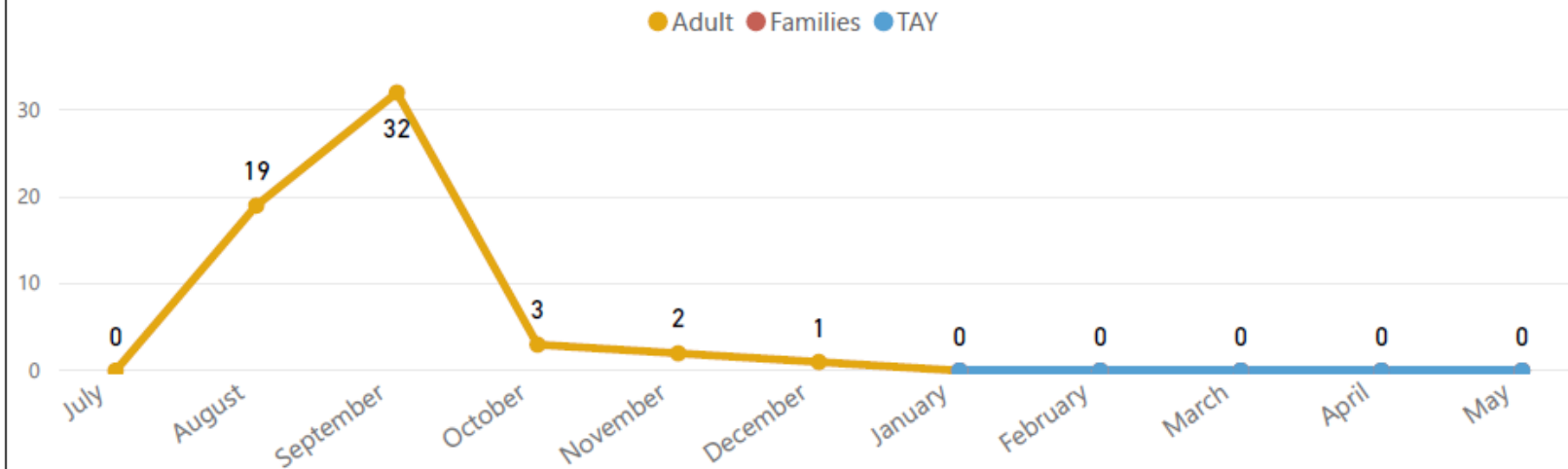

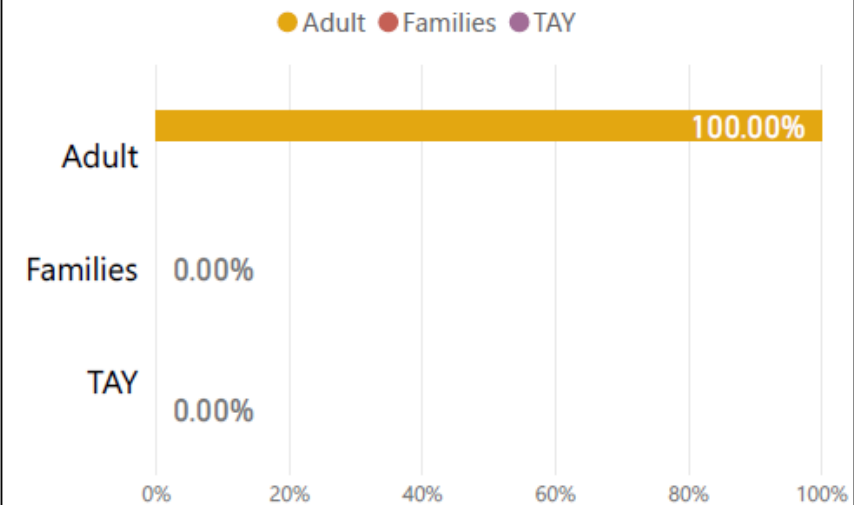
Housing Ladder Placements

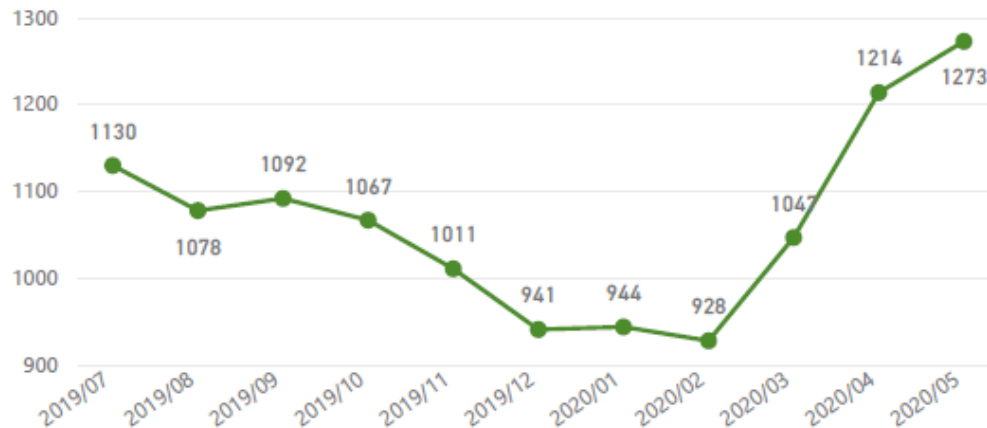

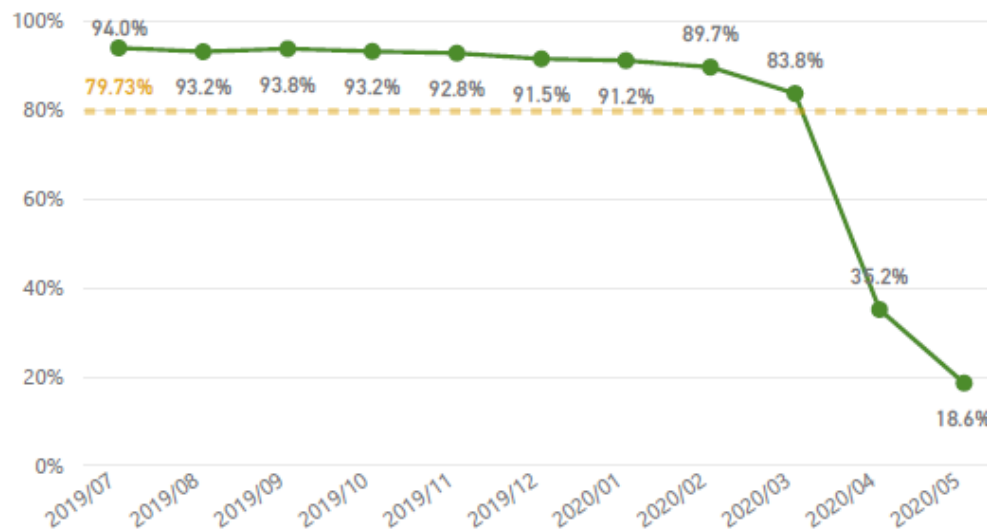

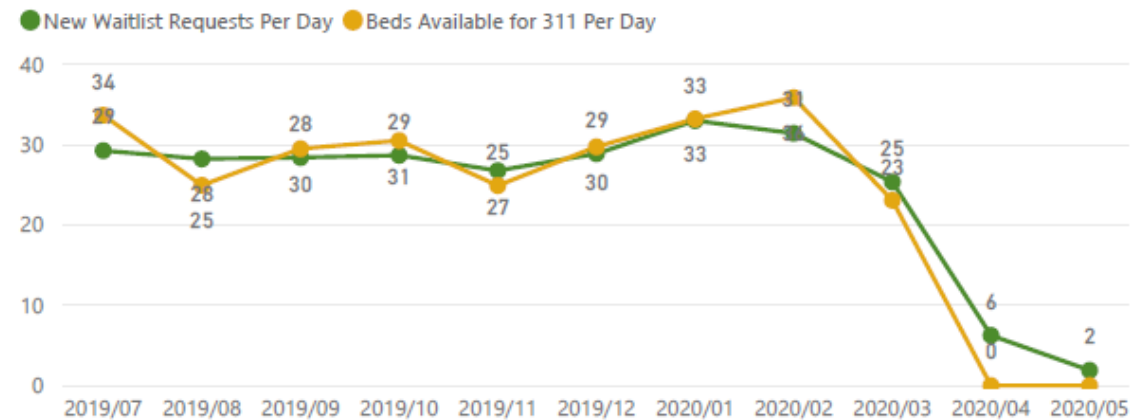

Occupancy Rate

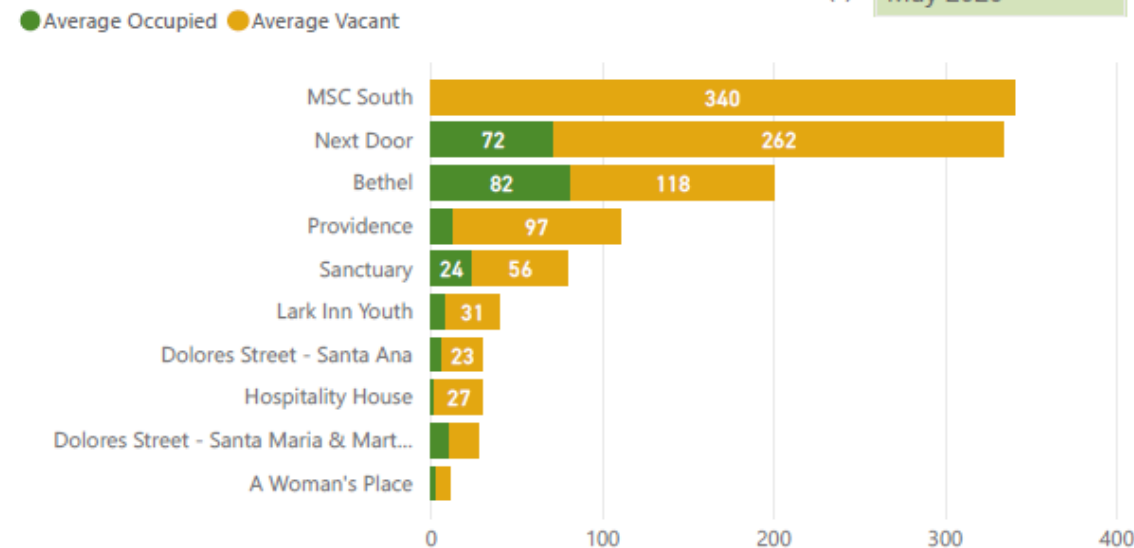


311 Available Beds vs. New Waitlist Requests

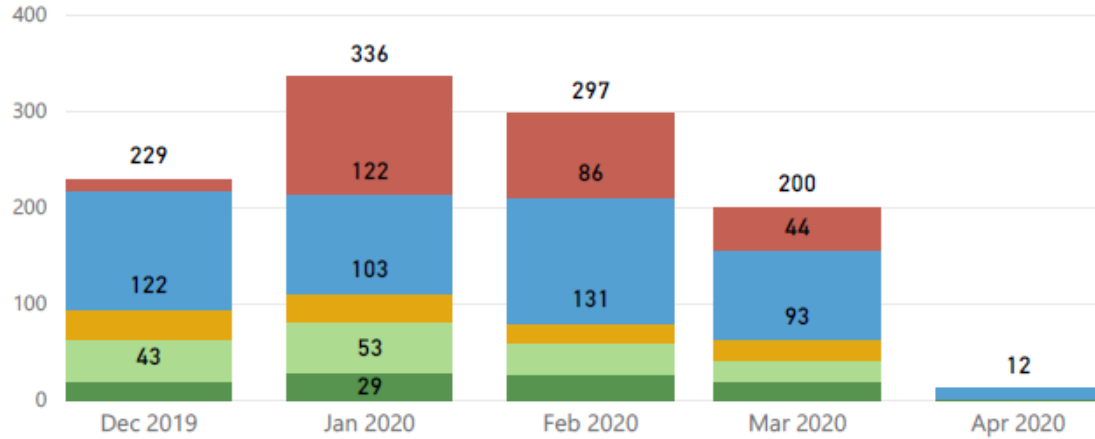

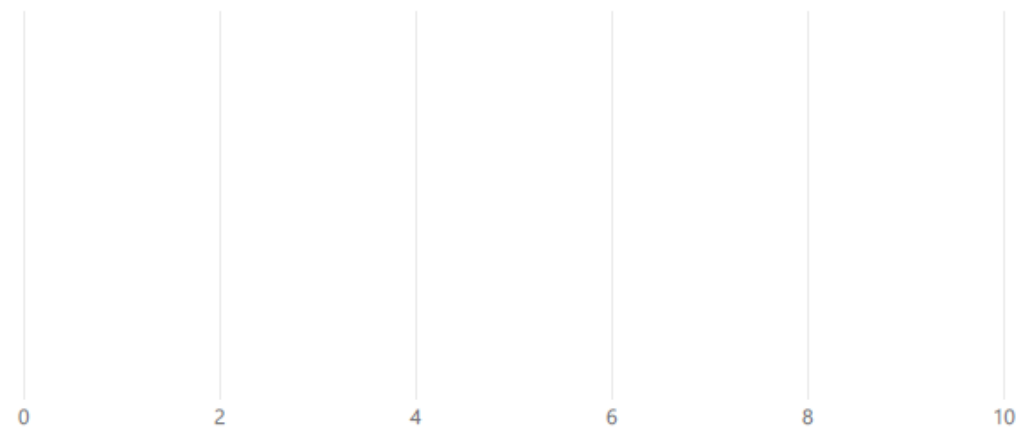

Intakes by Navigation Center for the previous 6 months for the reporting period ending in 5/31/2020

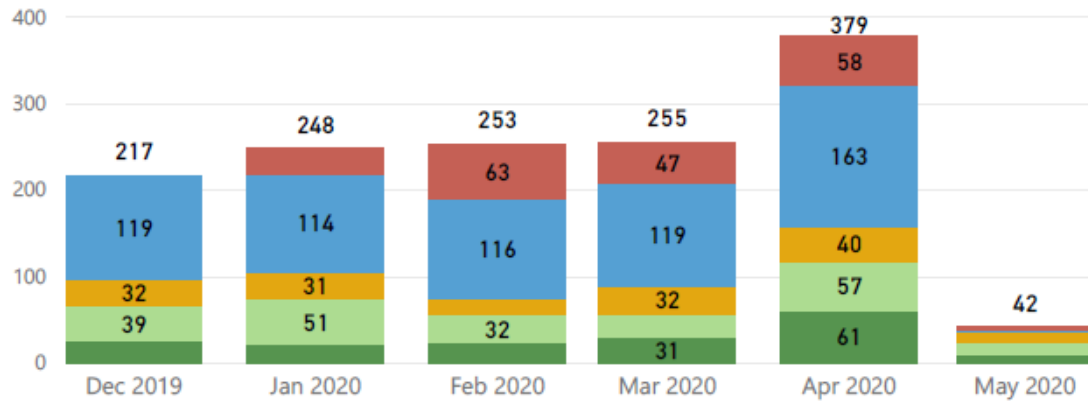
Intakes by Type of Stay



Intakes occurring within the reporting period 5/1/2020 to 5/31/2020

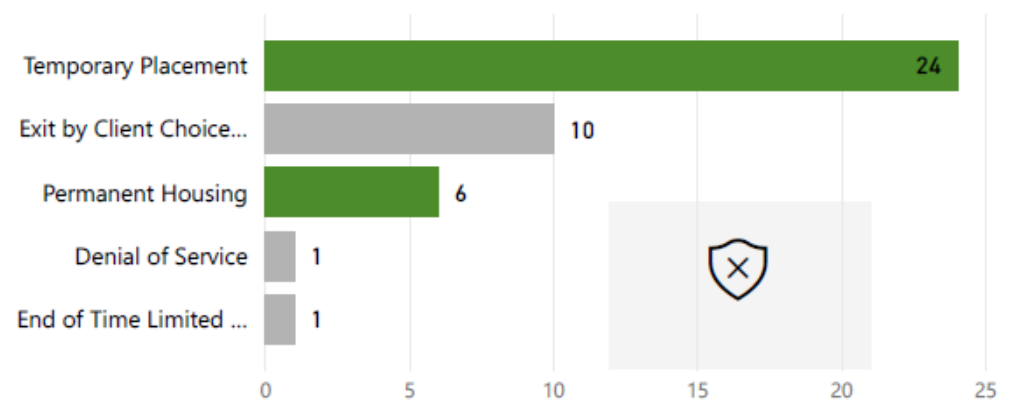

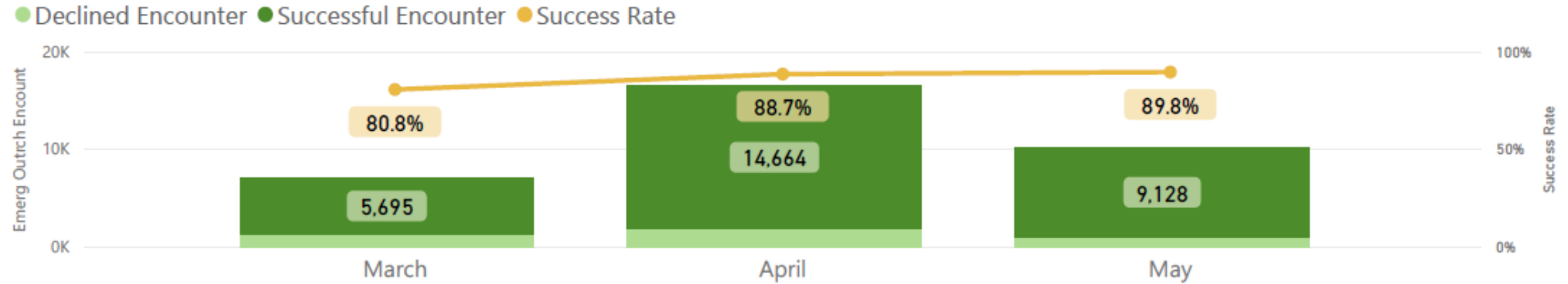

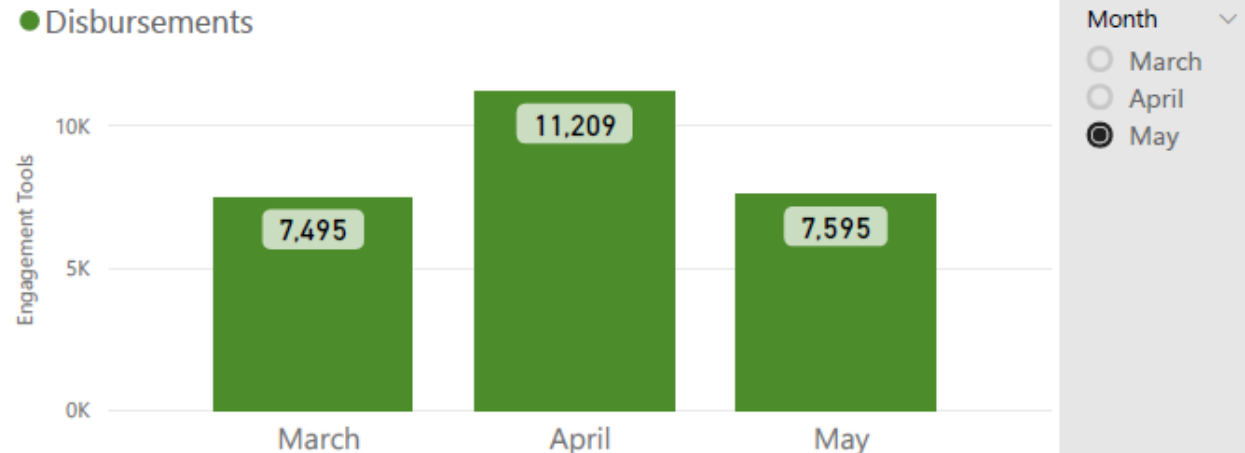

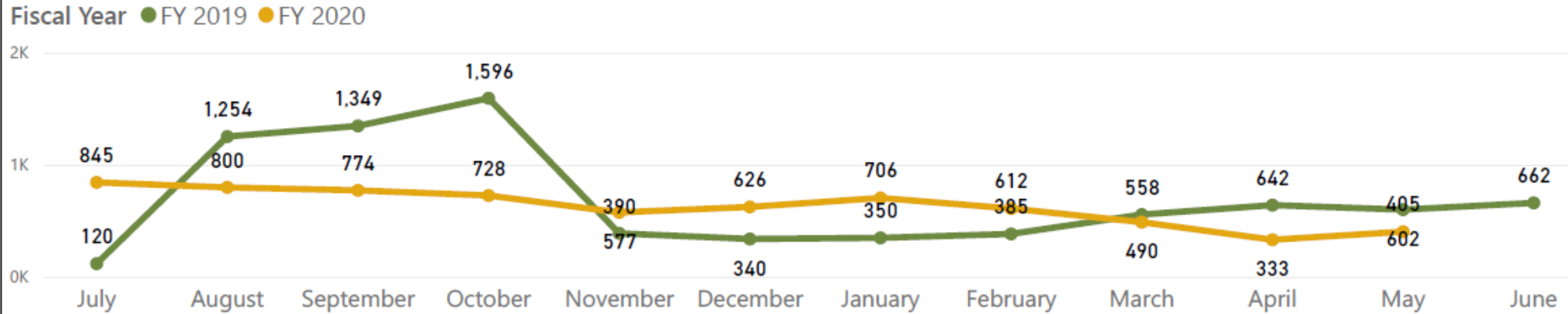

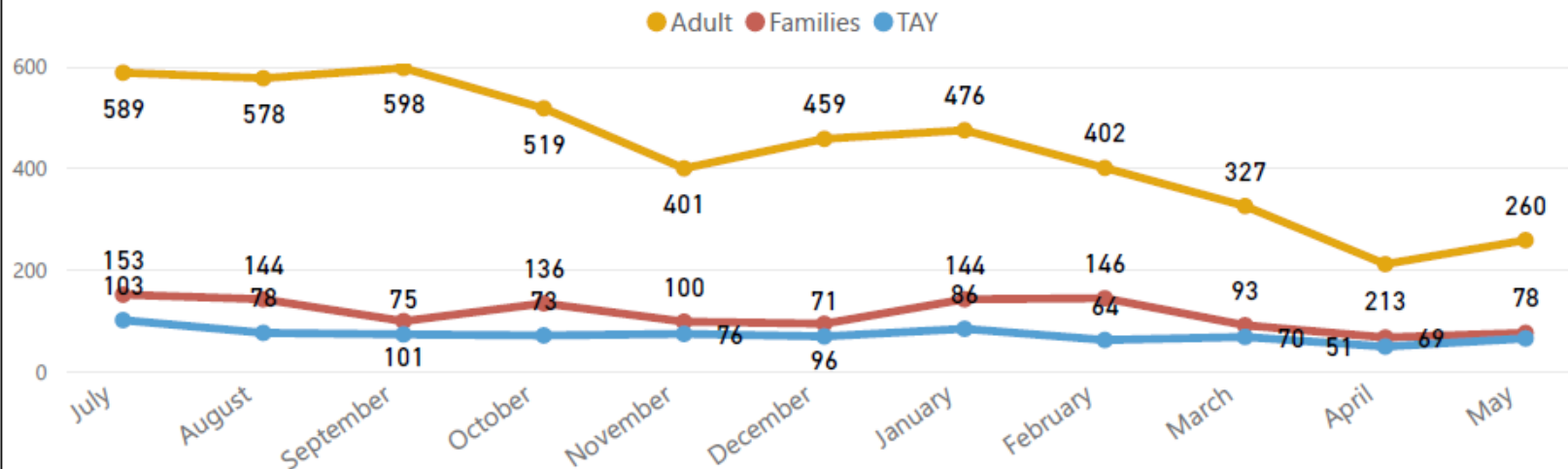

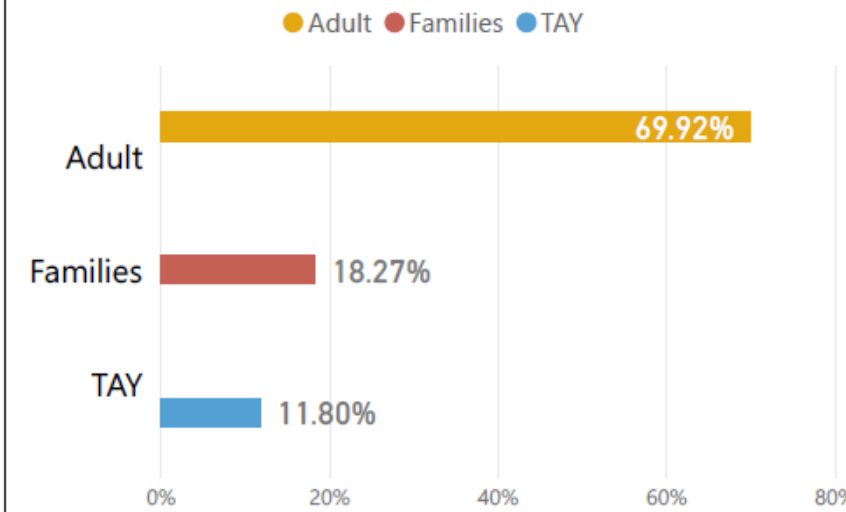

Program Highlights

Coordinated Entry and HSH Housing Teams

- Expedited the housing placement process.
- Hosted two leasing fairs with The Cadillac and THC.

Homeward Bound

- Changed intake model due to COVID-19 including online referral form.
- Working with Miracle Messages to assist clients with family reunifications.

833 Bryant

- 145 units of new PSH.
- Continuing Mayor's effort to open over 1,000 new PSH units by the end of 2024.

Emergency Outreach SFHOT

- Working with Street Medicine to place clients in SIP rooms.
- Working with HSOC for Tenderloin SIP Placements, Citywide COVID Outreach, and Safe Sleep Village Placements.
- Outreach services added to ACE Mobile Access Point

Partnered with Catholic Charities

- Opened 63 Room Stay in Place Hotel.
- Shelters families who have been exposed to COVID-19.
