














Housing Ladder



Vacancy Summary Count



Shelter

The CCC continues to reinflate the congregate shelter system.

•Current adult congregate shelter system capacity is 741.

HSH is working in conjunction with 5 Keys to reopen Next Door Shelter on December 28th.

•Bed capacity 149.

The CCC is opening a modified Winter Shelter Program starting November 30th.

- •Client referrals are from the CCC centralized referral system. (clients are no longer able to make self-referrals).
- Overnight shelter.
- •Bed capacity 67.

Coordinated Entry

To accelerate housing placements, a Housing Fair was held for SIP guests on November 4th through the 6th.

- •65 matches made to PSH.
- •Assessments increased from 40% to ~75%. These % have increased further in recent weeks
- •The Housing Fair strategy will be integrated into the Rehousing and Site Demobilization Plan. Note, this may adjust pending health guidance

ECS Mobile Assessment Unit, HSH's Homeward Bound, HSH's SF HOT, and SIP Care Coordinators are collaborating to assess all phase 1-3 SIP Hotels guests by year's end (phase 4 by end of January)

•Assessments help determine housing allocations and assist with the housing match process.

HSH is working with the DMV to assist individuals in the SIP hotels to expedite the process to obtain identification.

Housing

In partnership with MOHCD and ECS, HSH continues to work on the acquisition of the Diva Hotel.

The Granada Hotel has been acquired. HSH in partnership with The CCC, CE, and ECS are developing a plan to move SIP site guests to the hotel in the coming weeks.



2021 Point-in-Time (PIT) Count

- The 2021 PIT Count section is live on the HSH website.
- The PIT Count will be held on January 28, 2021 from 9:00pm to 12:00am pending any changes caused by surge/purple tier status
- This year's count will incorporate public health guidance to reflect COVID informed practices, supporting the health and safety of enumerators and persons experiencing homelessness.
