



Data through Dec. 31, 2022

Street Wellness Response Team: December Update

Total Number of Encounters (December): 473

• Average response time: 14 minutes | Average time on call: 38 minutes

Origin of call: 50% dispatch

- Steady increase in rate of calls coming from 911 rather than on-views
- Context: Dispatch accounted for 12% of calls in July 2022 and 30% in October 2022.


Result of encounter

- 98 ambulance transports to hospital.
- 95 non-ambulance transports to various locations.
- 234 remained in community.

Coordinated Entry - Assessments






Program Updates: Coordinated Entry

- → New Housing Referral Status ranges became effective on January 26, 2023.
- Family and Adult, and Youth PSH eligibility has narrowed.
- ► Youth RRH has expanded.
- →Ranges are interim until the Coordinated Entry Redesign Process is complete, which may result in changes.




Coordinated Entry & Housing Demographics

Sexual Orientation is incomplete for 7% of clients (5% Data Not Collected; 2% Refused)






Gender is incomplete for 1% of clients (1% Data Not Collected; 0% Doesn't Know / Refused)

■ At Risk of Homelessness ■ Fleeing Violence


Interim Progress Report:









Housing Vacancies over Time

Program Highlights: Housing

- → HSH received approval to accept and expend \$16.8 million in Homekey funding for 5630 Mission Street, our final Homekey Round 2 property.
 - In total, the City has received \$212.6 million in the two rounds of Homekey funding to acquire and operate six PSH sites.
- City Gardens will start to lease up family units in March.
- Full occupancy achieved in January at 1064-1066 Mission and Mission Bay SB 9
- Enhancements for equity in the PSH portfolio are rolling out. Increased funding to adult PSH providers to:
 - Reduce case management client ratio to 1:25.
 - Increase case management wages to a minimum of \$28/hour.



Program Updates: Shelter

- **∽SIP Hotels:** Housed 1,806 guests; <u>updated webpage available.</u>
 - Final SIP Hotel, 685 Ellis Street, is operating as semi-congregate shelter and HSH anticipates conversation to PSH in 2023.
- ►Inclement Weather shelters:
 - Activation for more than half the month of January during rain and cold snaps.
 - Information in the Department's email blasts and posted on the HSH website.
- Shelter Budget Rebase and Enhancement Working Group:
 - Standardizes case management ratios (1:25 for adults, 1:15 for families); sets wage floors for entry level staff (\$22/hour for monitors; \$28/hour for case managers).
 - HSH convening a case management working group to establish clear, standardized policies, protocols, and responsibilities for case managers across sites.
- Development work and community process has begun for a non-congregate cabin site in the Mission; plans to open the site in late 2023.
 - HSH designing site with DPW | Community meetings in January and early February.




Overview: Homelessness Recovery Plan

- ←Guided shelter and housing expansion during the City's response to COVID-19 between July 1, 2020, and Dec. 31, 2022.
 - Met all six goals.
 - Original timeline of 2 years extended due to continued impacts of COVID-19.
- Leveraged unprecedented new resources:
 - Local Prop C dollars
 - State Roomkey and Homekey funding
 - Federal **FEMA** dollars.

Goal: Purchase/Lease 1,500 New PSH Units




• Definition:

Includes all sitebased or scattered site PSH opened or under contract between July 1, 2020 and Dec. 31, 2022 (including MOHCD pipeline projects).

Result: Met 205% of this goal!




Goal: Reach 2,100 Beds in the Adult & Youth Shelter Systems



- **Definition:** Includes new or reopened beds serving adults and youth 18-24.
 - Excludes Safe Sleep,
 Vehicle Triage Center,
 Transitional Housing, and
 seasonal or overflow
 programs.
- Result: 114% of goal reached with 2,402 beds as of Dec. 31, 2022.




Goal: Make 6,000 Placements to Shelter & Housing



- Definition: Includes adult and youth shelter beds added and placements to all housing programs between July 1, 2020, and Dec. 31, 2022.
- Result: 117% of goal reached with 7,047 placements as of Dec. 31, 2022.



Goal: Make 3,000 Placements to PSH



- Definition: all placements to site-based and scattered-site Permanent Supportive Housing.
- Results: 117% of goal reached with
 3,505 placements between July 1, 2020, and Dec. 31, 2022.





Additional Updates

Chief Equity Officer Update

- → Monthly DEI community events will be enriched by guest speakers.
- **Coaching Circle** pilot begins on February 13 for emerging leaders of color. ◆
- **→Staff listening sessions** in February and March to inform racial equity professional development sessions.
- ► Equity in Action (consultant) is **convening BIPOC provider leaders** in February to set **goals for capacity building** with providers.
